BRIDGE TO DREAMS

It's that time of year that we start to plan for Bridge to Dreams season. You will recall that this is the Southbridge project which aims to help residents fulfill objectives they hadn't thought possible since they moved into a long term care home. Last year we had 5 very successful projects and we would aim to accomplish the same again. Please speak to your family member about this and if they have an unfulfilled dream let us know.

Behavioral Supports Ontario, or BSO as it is known, is a program set up by the Ministry to provide expertise, support and resources to residents of long term care homes. The intended outcome of BSO is to provide the right support at the right time and place to reduce the negative impact of responsive behaviors on their quality of life. BSO activities include individual interventions, such as one to one attention and specific programming, as well as educational activities.

The Ministry, through the LHIN, recently announced an increase in BSO funding throughout the province. For Bayfield this means we will be increasing BSO support to 3 days a week. (8 hour shifts). Our 2 BSO champions are Sarah Crawford and Jennifer Brown, both are PSWs who have been with us for over 10 years. They will now be able to expand their excellent work supporting their coworkers and will be working with activity staff to ensure that they are also involved in BSO interventions.
